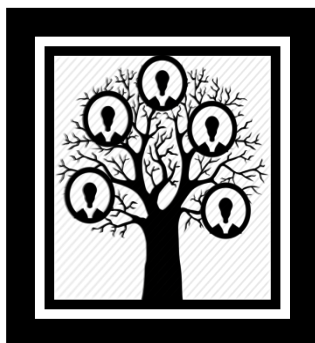


Genealogy Workshops

Introduction to Genealogy

This introductory is designed to help students discover the fundamental building blocks of genealogical research. You will also learn how to document your family history.

Students will learn how to use the internet for family history research, explore popular genealogy websites, and discover technique for getting the most out of internet search engines and databases.

Building Your Family Tree

This course will cover techniques using Microsoft Word and Powerpoint for displaying genealogy history for presentations. Participants should have basic knowledge of Microsoft operations.
